Important Notice: Par Knowledge-Intensive EIS Fund IV

This Application Form has been issued by Par Fund Management Limited ("PXB Group", "PXB Investments", "Par Equity" or the "Manager"), which is authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority ("FCA") with registered number 485668.

The Application Form has been issued in relation to an information memorandum (the "Memorandum") on the Par Knowledge-Intensive EIS Fund IV (the "Fund") managed by the Manager. The Fund is promoted solely on the basis of the Memorandum and accompanying documentation and may not be promoted to the public. Only specific types of investor may receive a promotion in relation to the Fund. If you are in any doubt as to whether you should have had the Fund promoted to you, you should consult an appropriate professional adviser who specialises in advising on funds of this type.

Don't invest unless you're prepared to lose all the money you invest. This is a high-risk investment, and you are unlikely to be protected if something goes wrong.

Nature of the Fund

The Fund is a restricted mass market investment ("RMMI") as defined by the FCA and the investments it makes may not be readily realisable. Accordingly, the Memorandum may only be received by, and this application form may only be completed by or on behalf of, certain classes of investor, as described below.

Investors Able to Invest in the Fund

The FCA Rules require that applications may **only** be accepted from three categories of investor:

- 1) Retail investors who have received financial advice before receiving the Memorandum to the effect that an investment in the Fund is suitable for them ("Advised Investors") in accordance with the requirements of the FCA Rules (COBS 4.12A.17R)
- 2) Retail investors who have NOT received such financial advice ("Non-advised Investors"), but who satisfy the relevant requirements set out in the FCA Rules (COBS 4.12A.15), namely investors
 - a) In respect of whom the Manager has undertaken an assessment as required by 4.12A.27R, and
 - b) Who fall within ONE of the following categories in accordance with COBS 4.12A.21R:
 - i) Certified High Net Worth Investor;
 - ii) Certified Sophisticated Investor;
 - iii) Self-Certified Sophisticated Investor;
 - iv) Restricted Investor.
- 3) Investors and intermediaries who have agreed to be classified as Professional Clients as per COBS 3.5.

This Application Form has been prepared specifically for Advised Investors who have received financial advice pursuant to COBS 4.12A.17R as described above.

Information relating to the Fund and Obtaining Advice

Step 4: Next Steps

The following steps cover what happens after we have received and approved your Application Form and our Administrator, Kin Fund Services, are in receipt of your funds:

1. You will be sent a confirmation note from Kin Fund Services that your funds have been received and your funds will be invested as set out in the Information Memorandum
2. You will then receive investment confirmations as and when your Subscription is invested in specific companies, including the amount invested, the number of shares you hold and share price
3. As investments are made and after HMRC has certified the applications, you will also receive EIS 3 certificates. We will endeavour to have these sent out promptly following each investment, but as we are reliant on the cooperation of other parties, this process may take several months
4. You will receive bi-annual reports, including valuations and updates on the progress of companies held in your portfolio. In the intervening quarters, you will also receive valuation statements
5. As investments in your portfolio are realised, we will also notify you of your sale proceeds (if applicable) and provide a reminder of your likely tax position depending on the holding period of the investment, whether the investment returned a profit or loss and any other relevant factors. We will also provide details of deductions in respect of arrears of Annual Management Charges and/or our performance fees, if applicable
